

WEATHER POLICY

Safety policies and procedures will be strictly enforced to ensure the safety and well being of all participants. In the event of adverse weather, OTE Technicians will initiate a weather related delay.

RAIN

Typically an event can continue to operate in rain. When rain is so heavy that participants lose vision or some other unsafe condition exists, OTE Technicians will initiate a weather related delay until rain eases enough to continue safely.

WIND

In the event of sustained winds of twenty-five (25) mph, or gusts lasting twenty (20) seconds of twenty-five (25) mph, OTE Technicians will initiate a weather related delay. The event will continue once the weather conditions improve.

LIGHTNING

A weather related delay will be initiated if lightning strikes are within forty (40) miles from the rappel site. The event will continue once the weather conditions improve.

ALTERNATE RAPPEL DATE

In the event of significant weather delays on Friday, March 18, 2016, individuals unable to rappel due to unforeseen weather delays will have the opportunity to rappel on Saturday, March 19, 2016.
